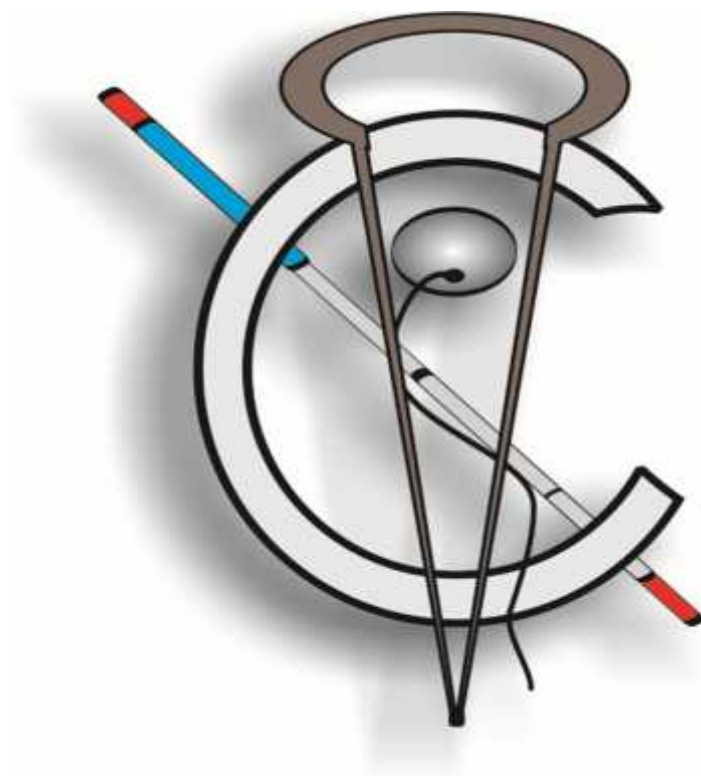

1. HEALTH CARE AND REHABILITATION CENTRE (HCRC)

At Present the Centre is providing physiotherapy and speech therapy to 29 needy Children with disabilities. Most of the children are Cerebral Palsy and they are economically poor that they cannot afford for fees to the therapist. The Foundation is providing the therapist to the 0 – 25 years with free of cost. Also we are proving them 50% of the transportation fare. HCRC was opened from the 10th September 2012. Rehabilitation work i.e. physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, Learning foundation, home based therapy, medical

checkup and parents counseling. Seeing the need of early intervention to children with disabilities for their bright future, the Integrated Day Care Unit was set up on the 10th August 2016 as a unit under Health Care and Rehabilitation Centre run by Handicapped Development Foundation, Manipur. **Our organization** provides some of the physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, Learning foundation, home based therapy, medical checkup and parents counseling. Play therapy is also a method of meeting and responding to the mental health needs of children and is extensively acknowledged by experts as an effective and suitable intervention in dealing with children's brain development. In our day care center play therapy has been performed every Wednesday as a schedule.



2. DIRECT CHILD ASSISTANT (DCA).

Since September 2012, HD Foundation started Direct Child Assistance with the support of Jan Vikas Samiti –Liliane Fond; we had supported 59 Children in terms of Health, Education, Vocational training, and social empowerment. At present the foundation is supporting to 55 Children with various disabilities below the age of 25 years. We also provide Home base therapy to those who are not able to come to the center.

Kameshwar Singh, District Social Welfare Officer, Imphal West, Govt. of Manipur as guest of Honour and Dr. ChongthamNarendra, Advocate as resource person. The program was started by presentation to dignitaries by the members of HD Foundation, Manipur followed by candle lighting by dignitaries. Welcome and key note addressed by Dr.SapamJasowanta Singh, Secretary General, HD Foundation, Manipur then followed by speech by Dr. ChongthamNarendra, Advocate, he explained briefly about RPD Act2016 and did interaction among the audience and said that it is a New Law and it is highly essential to know about it.A. Kameshwar Singh, District Social Welfare Officer, Imphal West, Govt. of Manipur, address about direct benefit transfer for disability pension and requested to all persons with disabilities with degree 80% to submit require documents like disability certificate, Aadhar card, bank account and photos etc. to the D.C. Th. Kamini Kumar, Law Secretary, Govt. of Manipur said about the new law and expect the new Government will help in implementing it. The function was finished with Vote of thanks. In that function around 100 people were attended.

This Council will be an autonomous body but till it can stand alone, will be under the guidance of our foundation. As per the resolution of the council – Thangjam Saratkumar, Gurumayum Geeta Devi and Aribam Jibanlata were executed as founder President, Secretary and Treasurer along with other 8 (eight) members among the 94 parents present in the convention.

10TH BARRIER FREE CAMPAIGN

Opening Ceremony: On the 16th October, 2017 the Barrier Free Campaign Committee which comprises of Handicapped Development Foundation, Manipur, and Parents Guardian Council of Persons with Disabilities in collaboration with Social Welfare Department had organized the 10th Fortnight Barrier Free Campaign, 2017. The Programme started at 10:45a.m. Shri. Th. Prameshwor Singh, Scientist-G & Executive Director, National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) was the Chief Guest, Shri. Th. Harikumar Singh, CEO, Imphal Smart City Ltd., Municipal Commissioner, Imphal Municipal Corporation and Shri. Dr.Ch. Rupachandra Singh, Chairman, Handicapped Development Foundation, Manipur were the Guests of Honor, Shri. Th. Sarat Kumar Singh, Convener, Barrier Free Campaign Committee was the President. The campaign was presiding by the President followed by candle lighting by the Dignitaries and simple gifts were presented to the dignitaries. The Welcome & keynote address was given by Dr. Sapam Jasowanta Singh, Secretary General, Handicapped Development Foundation, Manipur. The Chief Guest said that a barrier free environment does not mean only for persons with disabilities and old age persons but it means for everyone so to make a universal design in every field is essential. Also he added that he will help in learning computer to disabled children if required by sending their concern staffs.

In Class X category 4 students had been given with scholarship amount of Rs. 300/- per month & for Class XII category 7 students had been given with scholarship amount of Rs. 500/- per month. Around 130 members were present. The programme concluded around 2:20p.m with vote of thanks. The Handicapped Development Foundation and Himachal Consultancy Organisation LTD. (HIMCON), Shilmahad conducted a three months Vocational Training on **Hand Embroidery, Sewing Machine Operator and Bamboo and Craftat** Ningthoukhong, Bishunupur District (Manipur), Imphal West and Senapati, on behalf of Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC). The main objective of the training was motive to help themselves (person with disabilities) to sustain their life by generating income in their leisure time through the skill enhance during the training.

Hand Embroidery Training atNingthoukhong, Bishnupur District (Manipur)-The training was imparted 25 persons with disabilities. Presently 10 of the trainees have started earning. The HD Foundation also helped in their marketing by linking them with venders and handloom enterprises.

Sewing Machine Operator at Imphal West- Sewing Machine Operator Training was implemented at Imphal West starting from the month of the April. A total of 50 persons with Disabilities were benefited.

Bamboo and Crafts Training at Senapati - The training was implemented through the Senapati Disability Persons Association, Manipur, (SDPAM) and a total of 25 persons with Disabilities were benefited.

There are many students with disabilities who could not get their higher education due to lack of their study materials and many of them could not afford for the reader fee. The foundation is trying to help those ambitious students with the little resource we have. The books in the audio format have been distributed to the beneficiaries at free of cost and the foundation also welcome others too to avail the same benefit.
